

1-day Lake Atitlán



06:00** Leave for Panajachel - you will be picked up at your hotel/homestay (05:45-06:15am. If time allows, there will be a breakfast stop on the way!

08:30-09:00 Arrive in Panajachel.

09:15 You will be taken down to the dock where to board the boat and handed a ticket for the boat tour.

09:30 Start boat tour of stunning Lake Atitlán visiting San Pedro La Laguna, Santiago Atitlán with its great art galleries and the Maximón sanctuary, and San Antonio Palopó, offering a great selection of hand woven products.
You will have between 45 minutes and 1 hour at each village. Pay close attention to the next departure time before you disembark at each village, as the boat will not wait for you.

A natural treasure is the sapphire-blue **Lake Atitlán**, surrounded by 3 dormant volcanoes in the Western Highlands. Located around the lake's shore are 14 picturesque indigenous villages which are home to Kakchiquel and Tzutuhil families and where Mayan dialects are first language.

15:00-15:30 Return to Panajachel

16:00 Leave for Antigua.

18:30 Arrive back in Antigua.

**Minimum of 4 passengers required for this departure!
